## The Itinerary

**23 October 2010 To Delhi**

Fly direct from Heathrow to Delhi on Jet Airways. Departures from regional airports are available on request.

**24 October 2010 Delhi**

Morning arrival in Delhi and transfer to The Lalit Hotel. Afternoon sightseeing of Old Delhi includes: an exhilarating rickshaw ride to the Jama Masjid through the bustling Chandni Chowk market and back streets – once the centre of the Mughal city – Shah Jehanabad. Finally continue onto the Raj Ghat – Mahatma Gandhi's cremation site, before returning to the hotel. 2 nights @ The Lalit Hotel.

**25 October 2010 Delhi**

Morning sightseeing of pulsating New Delhi including the impressive Humayun's Tomb, Qutub Minar and India Gate. Afternoon at leisure.

**26 October 2010 To Mandawa**

Morning drive to Mandawa. Afternoon sightseeing of the village with its delightful fresco festooned Havelis once owned by rich Merchants. Overnight at Castle Mandawa.

**27 October 2010 To Bikaner**

After breakfast drive to Bikaner. Afternoon sightseeing includes the magnificent Junagarh Fort – a mighty bastion protecting the land from both invader and the encroaching Great Thar Desert. Overnight at the Laxmi Niwas Palace.

**28 October 2010 To Jaisalmer**

Morning drive deep into the heart of the desert to Jaisalmer. Two nights at Gorband Palace Hotel.

**29 October 2010 Jaisalmer**

Morning visit the inhabited hilltop Fortress and roam the streets finding hidden corners where delightful frescoes adorn the beautiful Merchant houses. Jaisalmer was a strategic town on the ancient caravan routes and is awash with history and intrigue. Afternoon excursion to take a camel ride in the Sam sand dunes and view the beautiful sunset.

**30 October 2010 To Luni via Jodhpur**

After an early breakfast drive to Jodhpur. Visit the 15th c. Meherangarh Fort soaring above the city, with its delightful insight into the life and times of the ruling family. Also visit the quiet Jaswant Thada – a marble memorial built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II. Continue driving to Luni Overnight at Fort Chanwa.

**31 October 2010 To Udaipur via Ranakpur**

Morning drive to Udaipur en-route visiting the beautifully carved marble 15th c. Jain temples of Ranakpur. The sensitivity of the carving on the 200 hundred pillars is astonishing. Two nights stay at the Fatehgrah Palace.

**01 November 2010 Udaipur**

Morning sightseeing of Udaipur includes the City Palace Complex, the Jagdish Temple and the leafy Gardens of the Maids of Honour – once only open to Royal ladies. Afternoon at leisure to explore this delightful city.

**02 November 2010 To Jojawar**

Morning drive to village Jojawar and stay what was once the garrison fort of Jojawar. Visit the charming village in the afternoon and savour the excellent rural experience of Rajasthan. Overnight at Rawla Jojawar - a Heritage Hotel.

**03 November 2010 To Jaipur**

Morning drive to Jaipur. Two nights stay at Shahpura House.

**04 November 2010 Jaipur**

Like Royalty, seated in a howdah, upon the back of a stately elephant climb the winding hill to the magnificent Amber Fort. Built by the warrior Rajputs, the Fort is filled with memories of an ancient and heroic age. Afternoon visit the City Palace Museum, the Jantar Mantar Observatory dedicated to the celestial heavens and the Palace of Winds.

**05 November 2010 To Agra**

Drive from Jaipur to Agra visiting the world Heritage site of Fatehpur Sikri enroute. Stay at The Taj Gateway Hotel Agra.

**06 November 2010 To Delhi**

Enchanting dawn visit to the Taj Mahal, an eternal symbol of love. After breakfast visit Agra Fort, where Shah Jehan, imprisoned by his son, spent his last days gazing at his wife's Tomb. Also visit the Tomb of Itmad-ud-Daula. Early afternoon departure for Delhi. Stay at Leela Kempinski Hotel Gurgaon.

**07 November 2010 To London**

Transfer to International airport for your return flight home to London by direct Jet Airways flight.

Fly to Goa. Courtesy transfer by hotel's coach. Four nights at Taj Holiday Village or Cidade de Goa
